All participating artists of the *ISZAF Pattern Challenge* will be invited to submit their challenge work to be part of a curated exhibition. We are also extending this as an open call for work from any ISZAF Community member that did not participate in the challenge but would like to submit work created that is related to the idea of *Pattern*. Below are the details:

## **EXHIBITION VENUE:**

Online – virtual exhibition (due to COVID-19 restrictions). We are going to use the platform <a href="https://www.kunstmatrix.com/">https://www.kunstmatrix.com/</a>. Live link will be sent out when the exhibition opens.

Exhibition Dates: September 9-23/2021

Curation: Lead Curators: Gloria Carnevale and the ISNS IB DP Year 2 students, ISZAF Admin Team

#### TIMELINE:

Submission by artist of artwork to be considered for the show: August 23 (online format)

Curation process begins – selection of artwork for show: August 24 -26

Final Selection posted: August 30

Virtual Exhibition Set-up: September 6-8

Show goes live online: Thursday, September 9 @ 4pm

## **EXHIBITION EXPECTATIONS:**

- 1. ISZAF members are expected to finalize all of their work and send images of artwork submissions to Gloria Carnevale using the outlined procedures below on or before August 23, 2021 by 23:59 in the evening. Email all images of work to ISZAF at gloria.carnevale@isnsz.com Along with images of the work submitted, a word document must be submitted that includes the following:
  - a. Title of each work (If no title, please title it, "Untitled")
  - b. Date created (usually the date finished)
  - c. Brief Bio and Artist Statement (6 sentences max combined) for promotion
  - d. Your contact information (email, social media contacts and website)
  - e. High resolution image of your artwork for the virtual exhibition
- 2. All show work will be curated and selected by the ISZAF Curatorial Team and the ISNS DP Art Students. Not all work submitted is guaranteed to show. Work will be chosen based on media used, technical skill, composition and overall effect generated by the work.

- 3. Upon artists being selected for the show, they are expected to assist in the funding the virtual platform. A minimum donation fee of 40 RMB must be submitted to Gloria Carnevale via WeChat.
- 4. Participating artists will be expected to work with art students @ ISNS through the "Ask the Artist" activity. Students will ask artists about their artwork via an online form, and the artist will be required to respond to the questions via email to their teacher. Gloria Carnevale will coordinate this and will disclose more details about this.
- 5. We live in China, so work must be appropriate and respectful of this. Selected work should not show, refer to or demonstrate explicit subjects of any kind. This may include full frontal nudity, sexual acts, drug paraphernalia and/or consumption, excessive alcohol consumption or illegal activities. It cannot be highly political, nor should it offend our host country of P.R. China. If any participating artists have any questions about the subject to be explored in the work, they are to contact Gloria Carnevale with such questions.
- 6. We cannot sell your artwork as we are an artist community and not a commercial gallery. Your contact information will be available to prospective interested buyers and you are welcome to contact them personally for possible sales. ISNS will take no commission on exhibited artwork.
